

2020 JOURNAL ENTRY OF JUDGMENT (JE) EXPLAINER

This **highlighted** document is intended to explain the changes to the forms that will go into effect on July 1, 2020. These changes are due in part to the passage of new legislation which will go into effect on that date, while some changes are the result of feedback received from those who use the forms.

Please note that unless specified, the statutory (K.S.A.) references are intended to direct the user to the most current version of the statute. If a K.S.A. 2020 Supp. is referenced, this law is already in effect as of July 1, even though the statute itself has not yet been published.

PAGE 1

- The date in the title has been changed to be used for all crimes *committed* on July 1, 2020-June 30, 2021.

PAGE 1

- Box added to indicate if the Journal Entry of Judgment is amended. Additional language added to indicate page 5 has space to provide explanation of amendment.

PAGE 3

- Section VI. – Fields for costs associated with the prosecution adjusted to provide space for “Other Fees.”
- Section VI. – Pursuant to K.S.A. 22-6604 (b), line added for Court considered restitution plan. Statute requires that the defendant be given a specified time to pay or be allowed to pay restitution in specified installments or the court finds circumstances that would render restitution unworkable, either in whole or in part.

- Section VII. Box 12 – Language added to recap what specific counts have Firearms Special Rule finding and Domestic Violence Designation
- Section VII. Box 14 – Space added to explain amended filing if new Amended Filing box on page 1 is checked.
