1.	Amending the requirements for offender registration. See 2020 HB 2474 (Judicial Council) and 2019 HB 2051 (KSSC) .	Y N
2.	Allowing earned discharge credit for people on probation and parole/postrelease supervision. See 2019 HB 2052 .	Y N
3.	Increasing felony loss thresholds for certain property crimes – Eleven property crimes proposed to be raised from \$1,000 to \$1,500 for felony threshold. See 2020 HB 2485 .	Y N
4.	Changing certain penalties for drug crimes. See 2019 HB 2047 .	Y N
5.	Requiring legislative members of the sentencing commission to be members of senate judiciary and house corrections and juvenile justice as set forth in KSA 74-9102 . See 2020 HB 2493 .	Y N
6.	Clarifying concurrent or consecutive sentencing for persons convicted of new crimes while on release for a felony. See KSA 21-6604(f)(4) , KSA 21-6606(d) and 2019 HB 2046 .	Y N
7.	Extending terminal medical release to inmates in the custody of the department of corrections with a condition likely to cause death within 120 days. See 2020 HB 2469 .	Y N
8.	Creating a drug abuse treatment program for people on diversion and allowing county attorneys to enter into agreements with court services and community corrections for supervision. See 2020 HB 2002 , 2019 HB 2292 and 2017 HB 2087 .	Y N
9.	Clarifying jurisdiction and supervision of offenders in a certified drug abuse treatment program – All parties must agree to the transfer to offender’s SB 123 probation to the location where offender would be receiving usual courtesy supervision. See 2020 HB 2470 .	Y N
10.	Amending the criminal penalties for unlawful tampering with electronic equipment (SL6 np) – If an offender is on felony supervision and commits this crime, the violation would be a severity level 8, nonperson felony. If on misdemeanor supervision or court-ordered supervision in any civil case the violation would be a class A nonperson misdemeanor. See 2020 HB 2494 .	Y N

11.	Modification of Care and Treatment Law – Allowing courts to prohibit possession of a firearm in a temporary custody order pursuant to the care and treatment act for mentally ill persons. See 2020 HB 2551 .	Y	N
12.	Modify Good Time and Program Credits – Current 15%-20% good time credit would be modified to 25% for person and 40% for nonperson felonies. Program credit would be increased from 120 to 150 days. See 2020 HB 2004 .	Y	N
13.	Enacting a program of early release and house arrest for certain inmates due to the COVID-19 pandemic. See 2020 SB 6 .	Y	N
14.	Early prison release for certain drug offenders (Judge Fowler’s 9/18/19 proposal). See attached Proposal 14.	Y	N
15.	Special Rule #26 – Determining prior convictions when charging drug crimes in same complaint (Chris Lyon to brief us from response to ACA Amanda Voth on 9/1/20). KSA 2019 Supp. 21-6805(f)(1) . See attached Proposal 15.	Y	N
