




## Breakdown of Sentences Imposed – FY 2022




## Historic KS Sentences & Prison Population


FY 1996 through FY 2022




## Breakdown of Drug v. Nondrug Sentences




## Breakdown of Person v. Nonperson Sentences




# Sentence Distribution by Gender




## Sentence Distribution by Race




# Sentence Distribution by Ethnicity





#### FY 2022 Incarceration Sentences by Race of Offenders






#### FY 2022 Incarceration Sentences by Age of Offenders at Admission





#### FY 2022 Incarceration Drug Sentences by Offense and Severity Level












# **FY 2022 Incarceration Sentences Drug Offenders by Severity Level**




### Distribution of FY 2022 Probation Sentences






### Distribution of FY 2022 Probation Sentences by Gender





### Distribution of FY 2022 Probation Sentences by Race





# Distribution of FY 2022 Probation Sentences by Age




### FY 2022 Top Ten Offenses for Probation Nondrug Sentences




# FY 2022 Probation Drug Sentences by Offense



# Distribution of FY 2022 SB 123 by Severity Level, Gender, and Race





#### Distribution of FY 2022 Overall Guideline Sentences





Figure 51: Distribution of FY 2022 Dispositional Departure and Border Box Sentences






#### Distribution of FY 2022 Incarceration Guideline Sentences




# FY 2022 Incarceration Durational Departure Sentences

# Kansas eJournal Entry/ePSI Project

#### Domo Inc.

- Kansas partnered with Domo Inc. to create the Kansas Sentencing App
- Site allows for the creation of the electronic PSI, Sentencing Journal Entry, and Probation Violation Journal Entry
- Can be signed electronically by all parties
- Transfers data from the PSI to the Journal Entry
- Can create a new case from an already existing case
  - Frequent fliers
  - Criminal history already exists in the new PSI
