STEP 1:

Areas of Detail- Training:

STEP 1 & STEP 2-THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- T4C OR CBIC: Detail the integration process and how it will be used in conjunction with the CBIC curriculum
- T4C-Must be taught / facilitated from the scripted curriculum manual
- SAP: No need for an additional evidenced-based curriculum unless the providers desires to integrate one. However, this curriculum must be taught as intended in its entirety along with the stated structure of the curriculum

Curriculum- *Identify the CBIC curriculum to be used, Detailed Weekly Treatment schedule needed here, any offsite locations need to be noted, note the evidenced based curriculum that will be integrated with the CBIC concepts(what EBP: copy content page and star lessons to be integrated plus note on the treatment schedule), note plans to utilize the curriculum outline with clients other than SB123 clients- please make it clear in your plan whether the two populations will be integrated.*

Instructions for Plan Completion (Cont.):

Section II (cont.)

2. Treatment Plans:

- A. *Outline intentions for ensuring that evidence- based curriculums and cognitive behavioral based treatment concepts will be addressed in each SB123 client's treatment plan for each modality.*
- B. *How will treatment plans align with the supervision plan created by Comm. Corrections.*
- C. *Indicate the agency supervision & audit process that will ensure KDOC trained clinicians have input into a client's treatment plan, effectively process and outline a cross section of completed group and practice work is filed into a client's file and is reviewed for completion and accuracy as to verify the internalization process of learning for SB123 client during their continuum of care.*
